Dear Parents,

The re-registration process for the 2018-2019 school year is now underway. First and foremost, I would like to begin by thanking each of you for your support of our faculty, staff, programs, and goals. We are privileged to bring you and your children the very best that Catholic education has to offer!

In order to accept new students for the 2018-2019 school year, it is necessary to determine the exact number of students planning to return to Saint Anne next year. We have many new families seeking admission; therefore, we ask you to return all forms and registration fees by Friday, February 16th. Should you need additional time to submit registration fees, please contact the School Office to arrange a payment plan. Failure to do so could forfeit your child's place for next year.

While there will be a slight increase in tuition, I am very pleased to inform you that our registration fee will remain the same for the next school year - \$350.00 per child. Despite the economy and ever-rising costs, we have always done our very best to keep registration and tuition increases to a minimum. The slight increase in tuition is necessary to meet the following challenges of the coming year: the continued rise in operational costs, textbooks, supplies, and educational equipment. Please remember: registration fees are non-refundable. In order to accept your application for re-registration, all tuition payments and fees must be current.

Once again, 2018-2019 will require the same number of volunteer hours: 6 hours of assistance for our annual Fun Fair, 3 hours for our Christmas Bazaar, 3 hours for our Sports BBQ and 6 additional hours during the school year. Fun Fair continues to be a wonderful success as a direct result of the tremendous support we receive from the parents and students of Saint Anne School. As always, I am extremely grateful for the generosity and dedication of all of our school families all year long! Thank you!
