Dear Saint Anne Families,

The 2020-2021 school year has been different, to say the least, from previous school years. We have not been able to do a lot of the fun events we are used to, especially fundraisers. Fundraisers, like the Walk-a-Thon, allows Saint Anne the opportunity to continue providing an outstanding Catholic education. Our mission's commitment is to the fundamental obligation to teach and live the Gospel message as well as preparing students to be productive, responsible and effective members of the world community. We are proud of the fact that we prepare students for life-time service to God and the quest for knowledge. The Walk-a-Thon's fundraising efforts will be for various school campus needs. Our goal is to raise \$20,000!

Students can begin getting pledges immediately. The attached pledge form must be used to track sponsors and pledges. Each student will complete 30 minutes of walking and that is why we are doing pledges per minute, not per lap. We are asking sponsors to pledge in whole dollar increments. Each pledge will be multiplied by 30 to find total amount due. Sponsors can use the alternative pledge option of a flat donation. All money will be collected and turned in to the child's homeroom teacher. Cash and checks are acceptable forms of payment. Please make checks payable to Saint Anne Catholic School.

We are very excited about this fundraiser and understand that some sponsors may not live close enough to make their payment through cash or check. In order to include everyone, we ask that you encourage out-of-town sponsors to call the school office, 702-735-2586, and make a payment over the phone using a credit or debit card.

Students will turn in their pledge form and any collected money to their homeroom teacher daily. The turn-in days will occur while we are on campus during the weeks of March 22nd and April 12th. Each classroom will keep track of monies raised and earn rewards as certain dollar amounts are met. As a school, we will also report daily funds raised through a large pledge meter display.

It has been an unusual year not being able to have large community events on campus, but we are so grateful that we have at least been able to have the children back on campus. Please use the coming weeks, March 22nd through April 16th, to support Saint Anne and get pledges!
